The Franciscan Outreach Board of Directors is pleased to announce that after a thorough search process, Richard Ducatenzeiler has been hired as the organization's new Executive Director. Richard will begin his new position on September 16, 2019.



Richard comes to Franciscan Outreach with more than 20 years of experience in the nonprofit sector, specializing in human services and housing development. He served as the Executive Director of Northside Housing and Supportive Services for more than six years. Northside Housing and Supportive Services serves men and women who are experiencing homelessness by providing housing and comprehensive supportive services. Richard also held the positions of Director of Administration at Chicago Cares and Director of Administration and Supportive Services at Inner Voice.

Richard is committed to serving our city's most vulnerable residents and making an impact toward ending homelessness in Chicago. He served as a board member of the Chicago Continuum of Care, an organization that works to prevent and end homelessness in Chicago. He also worked on the creation of the city's original Plan to End Homelessness in 2002 and in 2012; he assisted in the development of Chicago's Plan 2.0, an action plan to help improve access to housing and services for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

"I am very encouraged about Richard leading Franciscan Outreach as the new Executive Director," says Ed Jacob, outgoing Executive Director. "I am so grateful for my time at Franciscan Outreach. Knowing that Richard is taking over the role makes leaving the organization a little easier.
